

6th Grade Day Camp Fall & Spring

Where & When:

- September 7, 2017, at Golden Bell Camp in Divide
- May 23, 2018, at Golden Bell Camp in Divide
- On both days, we will depart the Middle School at 8:00 a.m. and return by 5:30 p.m. Transportation to and from camp provided via school bus.

Goals & Expectations:

- The goal of the Fall Day Camp is to bring together students from the three Woodland Park Re-2 elementary schools, as well as new students, to build one community that will promote the learning and growth of all students as they move through Woodland Park Middle School.
- The goal of the Spring Day Camp is to celebrate the successful completion of 6th grade through adventure and exploration of the outdoors.
- At both outings, students will be expected to follow the guidelines outlined in the WPMS Student Handbook. In the event of repeated or severe misbehavior by a student, parents will be contacted and asked to pick-up their student and take them home.

Cost: The total cost of both days is around \$95 per student. This includes transportation, camp usage, and meals. The cost for each student will be covered through a 6th Grade Camp Fee and fundraiser activities. **The initial fee for parents for will be \$40.00 and should be paid at registration.** To fund the remainder of the trip, we ask for all students to assist with the fundraiser.

Additional Information: Students will receive camp information including all schedules, suggested attire, and day pack recommendations one-two weeks prior to the trips. In addition, ROAR teachers will go through the schedule of activities and expectations during ROAR time the week prior to camp.
