Read the Following Rules

I, _____ (student's name) understand that the parking lot is the property of Woodland Park School District Re -2. I agree that the car driven will not be used to transport or store illegal items on school property. I agree that I will not use the school parking lot to violate a criminal law or school rule.

I understand and give school officials and/or school security guards consent to search the car and the car's contents at any time when it is parked on school property.

I authorize school officials and/or school security guards to seize any item that violates a criminal law or school rule or provides evidence of a criminal law or school rule violation.

1. Parking tags issued by the high school must be displayed on the rear view mirror with the number facing out toward the front windshield.
2. Parking tags are not transferable to other students' vehicles.
3. Any student without the parking permit properly displayed may be ticketed and fined.
4. Students receiving discipline referrals may lose their parking permits.
5. **Students are only allowed to park in the Student Parking Lots.**

6. Students parking in fire lanes will be ticketed and risk losing their parking permits.
7. Students parking in the Staff, Guest Teacher, or Visitor areas will be ticketed and risk losing their parking permits.
8. Students parking or driving in the food service area will be ticketed and risk losing their parking permit.
9. Students speeding, driving in the wrong direction, or driving recklessly on school property will receive a ticket and may lose their parking permit. The Woodland Park Police may also be called.
10. If you drive a vehicle that is registered to your family that will be displaying your parking tag, please notify the school office of license plate information and the duration that you will be driving this vehicle to school.
11. If you buy or change vehicles during the school year, please submit to the school office all new vehicle information that is listed on this form.
12. Students will not give, trade, or sell parking passes issued to them. Any violation of these rules may result in the confiscation of your parking pass. If you lose your parking tag, you will have to pay **\$30** to obtain a replacement. There will be a week delay before a new parking tag will be issued, and you will not be able to park in the student parking lot until you have your new tag.
13. Students will turn in their parking pass to the bookkeeper at the end of the school year or will be fined **\$30**.
14. All vehicles must be moved outside of the band practice area by 3:00pm during the fall season.
15. Woodland Park School District is not responsible for theft or damage of personal items in the parking area.
