Dear High School Students and Parents:

Welcome back for a new school year! I am looking forward to your student starting a new year of learning at Woodland Park High School. Thank you for being an active part of your student’s academic experience.

The bell schedule for the high school will remain the same as 2016-2017. The school day for the high school starts at 7:45 am and ends at 3:07 pm. Buses will leave from the bus loop at 3:15 pm. As a reminder, *students should not be in the building prior to 7:00 am or after 4:00 pm.*

We emphasize safety in our building. To that end all outside doors will be locked while school is in session. Students enter the building through the Panther doors up to the first bell. After that students must enter through the clock tower entrance. A staff member will be supervising the Panther doors before and after school. Visitors enter through the clock tower entrance by pressing the buzzer so our receptionist can let you in. Please adhere to our sign-in/sign-out procedures (the receptionist can answer any questions you may have).

Students will continue to meet one day a week with their Advisory teacher to cover topics such as: College in Colorado, building their high school portfolio, state testing preparation, registration, and post high school goals. Covering these topics during the Advisory period has proven to take less time away from classroom instruction. Attendance is mandatory and *students receive .25 credit per year for the completion of the Advisory program.* Three days a week students attend an academic intervention period. This time provides students the opportunity to make up school work, receive extra instruction, or study.

Returning students must verify their census information during one of the registration dates listed above. New students must complete the enrollment packet found on the district website at <http://www.wpsdk12.org/>. Bring your completed packet to your counseling appointment. Appointments may be made starting August 4, 2017, by calling the Counseling Center at 719-686-2074. **Seniors** need to complete the *Senior Information and Graduation Contract* forms on the Senior Packet page and turn them in at registration. **ALL** students must attend a registration date in order to complete the registration process and to pick up their class schedule.
