Reading & Writing:

- Read for about 100 minutes a week. You can read to your child or he or she can read to you.
- Continue practicing reading and spelling the words with beginning consonant blends: **sm, sc, sk, st, sw, dw, tw**
- Write a list of ideas for stories about your life and attach the list to the homework when you return it.
- Review reading and spelling sight words you do not already know without looking at them:
has, have, is, of, said, the, to, you, was, what, put, are, could, would, should, they, your

Math:

- Complete any math pages if they are sent home.
- Practice drawing and naming different shapes.
- Make a shape pattern with objects or drawing shapes.
 - Sometimes it's fun to use food to make shapes!
- Count on and back from numbers between 10 and 30.
