Reading & Writing:

- Read for about 100 minutes a week. You can read to your child or he or she can read to you.
- As you read, practice visualizing or making pictures in your mind.
- Using the attached practice sheet (Unit 15 Lesson 3), split the words into syllables and underline the vowels.
- Choose 4 or 5 of the following sight words and write them in a sentence. Also continue to practice any that you do not know.

- Practice writing about different experiences with your child. As they write, make sure they are using capitals, space, and end-marks.

Math:

- Complete any math pages if they are sent home and return.
- Practice left and right in multiple ways. For fun, play the Hokey Pokey!
- Put groups of objects in a line and practice finding different positions *several times*. For example: "Point to the 5th one from the left..."
