## Math:

- Complete math pages sent home and return.

- Talk about these numbers (make sure your child is saying/writing them correctly and not reversing them):  
**12, 20, 21, 13, 30, 31, 14, 40, 15, 50, 51, 16, 60, 61, 17, 70, 71, 18, 80, 81, 19, 90, 91**
