We began competing in the 2010 - 2011 school year. Every year since then, our teams have placed in the top 3 at the regional tournament which allowed them to progress to the state tournament. **In 2013, our team moved on to the Global competition** at the University of Tennessee, Knoxville. In 2014, our team was awarded the top award in DI - the DaVinci Award. This is presented to a team using exceptional technology in their solution.

Once again, in 2016 and 2017, we made it to the Global competition!

- In 2016, the students designed and built a working hovercraft.
 - In 2017, the team chose to do an outreach project - helping a local Veteran and his nonprofit organization train service dogs and present them to Veterans. They received the Renaissance Award and the Torchbearer Award for outstanding creativity and teamwork in their work.
 - Last year was all about robotics. The team of 4 designed and programmed a robot to travel through a 20 ft. X 20 ft. maze!
